### What does Clark County Credit Union do with your personal information?

#### WHY?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

#### WHAT?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and birth date
- Address and work phone number
- Income and employment information

#### HOW?

All financial companies need to share member's personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their member's personal information; the reasons Clark County Credit Union chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

<b>For our everyday business purposes –</b> such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

<b>Who is providing this notice?</b>	Clark County Credit Union
What we do	
<b>How does Clark County Credit Union protect my personal information?</b>	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
<b>How does Clark County Credit Union collect my personal information?</b>	We collect your personal Information, for example, when you <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• apply for a new account or apply for a loan.</li> <li>• ask us to check your credit or examine your accounts.</li> </ul>
<b>Why can't I limit all sharing?</b>	Federal law gives you the right to limit only <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes-information about your creditworthiness</li> <li>• affiliates from using your information to market to you</li> <li>• sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you</li> </ul> State laws and Individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.
<b>What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold Jointly with someone else?</b>	Nothing happens to any other account unless you specify each account that you want limited.
Definitions	
<b>Affiliates</b>	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Members Automobile Brokerage Services, Inc.</i></li> </ul>
<b>Non-affiliates</b>	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>Dixon Financial Group, LLC</i></li> <li>• <i>CUNA Mutual Insurance</i></li> </ul>
<b>Joint marketing</b>	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <i>MEMBERConnect Insurance</i></li> <li>• <i>Generations Gold Inc.</i></li> </ul>
